EVENT A: U.S. NAVY MEMORIAL, PLAQUE DEDICATION, LUNCH & DC SIGHTS

Friday, April 27th (10:00am-4:00pm)

Your day begins at the one and only *U.S. Navy Memorial* for a very special Plaque Dedication Ceremony & Lunch arranged by the USS Yosemite Association. Afterwards, there will be time at the memorial to browse the Navy Log & the gift shop. Board your coach to see the most famous sights that make Washington so spectacular. Your guide will relate interesting anecdotes while you enjoy a "windshield" tour of DC, with several photo stops along the way. Some of the sights that you will see include the *White House*, *Capitol Hill*, *The Senate*, *Supreme Court*, the *Treasury Building*, the *Pentagon*, *Fords Theatre*, *Watergate*, the *Kennedy Center*, the *Washington Monument* and much more, as time permits. EVENT B: HISTORIC MOUNT VERNON

Saturday, April 28th (10:00am-2:00pm)

You will make a pilgrimage to the home of America's greatest founding father, George Washington. Mount Vernon was the beloved home of George and Martha Washington from the time of their marriage in 1759, until General Washington's death in 1799. He worked tirelessly to expand his plantation from 2,000 acres to 8,000 and the mansion house from six rooms to twenty-one. Mount Vernon is the most popular estate in America. There will be ample time to visit the Mansion house and more than a dozen outbuildings, including the slave quarters, kitchen, stables and greenhouse. Don't miss the *Ford Orientation Center* and the new *Donald W. Reynolds Museum*. There are many options for lunch, on your own, at Mount Vernon, and there are some unique shops located on the estate.

EVENT C: MONUMENTS BY LAND & WATER

Sunday, April 29th (10:00am-4:00pm)

Board your luxury motor coach for a very special day. You will begin the day with a visit to the *Korean Memorial*, and the adjacent *Viet Nam Memorial*. Tour stops will also include the *IWO Jima*, and the *WWII Memorial*. Lunch will be on your own at a suitable location before taking the short drive to Georgetown to board your sightseeing cruise. As you cruise back to Alexandria, you will have wonderful views of the *Jefferson Memorial*, *John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts*, *The Washington Monument*, *Memorial Bridge*, and *the 14th St. Bridge*. Your cruise will dock back in Alexandria where your bus will be waiting. You have the option of taking the bus back to the hotel or spending some time in Old Town Alexandria, you may even want to stay for dinner. If you choose to stay in Old Town you are on your own for transportation back to the hotel. It is a short taxi ride, and the hotel offers shuttle pick ups in Old Town, check with the front desk for the exact pick up times.

- ~ All tour times are subject to change. A final itinerary is available at registration.

Reservations are due by March 16th, 2012. Late reservations accepted on a space available basis with a non refundable \$10 per person late fee. You should make a copy of this form for your records.
